Unique method and systematic structure build language naturally.

Our engaging presentation of sounds, images, and text helps learners absorb meaning intuitively, so learning is natural and rewarding. Up to 5 levels of instruction are available in each language. Each level consists of 4 units, and each unit contains 4 lessons. In each lesson, language is built systematically, with new vocabulary being introduced in the context of language previously learned, strengthening skills and retention.

Core lessons provide the language-learning foundation.

Core lessons build reading, writing, speaking, and listening skills as they introduce new words and concepts that are later refined in focused activities.

Focused activities refine specific skills.

Focused activities reinforce language learned in the core lesson while refining more specific parts of language, such as grammar, vocabulary, pronunciation, listening, and other key skills. Along the way, reviews reinforce content mastered in previous activities and lessons.

Focused activities

There are eight focused activities for each lesson, a Review and a Milestone.



The PRONUNCIATION activity

focuses on refining pronunciation by prompting learners to speak and compare their own pronunciation to that of a native speaker. As in other activities requiring speech, learners receive both visual and auditory feedback in real-time.



The VOCABULARY activity

reinforces language introduced in the core lesson through a combination of images, reading, and listening exercises to help learners retain new vocabulary.



The GRAMMAR activity

helps learners focus on the grammatical structures of the language that they are learning in the context of spoken language and written text.



The READING activity

connects lifelike imagery and written text to help learners build reading skills in the new language.



The WRITING activity

guides learners to type the language being learned, increasing spelling skills while reinforcing new vocabulary.



The LISTENING activity

provides added training in listening skills by presenting language learned in the core lesson, focusing on comprehension of the spoken language.

reinforces general content learned in each lesson. Our unique Adaptive Recall[™] feature reintroduces Review activities for each lesson with varied frequency based on learner achievement level.

take place at the end of each unit and simulate real-life conversations. The learner draws from the context presented through words and imagery, and forms questions and responses to keep the conversation going.
