

# Leveraging technology to strengthen language skills

#### Challenge

The Academy of Information Technology & Engineering (AITE) sought a language-learning solution that would support the four-year language requirement at the school. AITE needed a program that would build critical oral communications skills and prepare graduates for college. Due to block scheduling, AITE needed a solution that would provide continuity with foreign language classroom instruction between scheduled meeting times. The school sought a solution that would be scalable and flexible to support at-home study. In addition, finding a program that could supplement classroom instruction was important for a successful implementation. For languages not offered in the classroom, AITE looked for a solution that would support independent study to meet the language goals required for learners. Last, the school needed a language-learning platform that could support professional development objectives of faculty and staff.

## Implementation

AITE implemented both the Rosetta Course® and TOTALe® PRO K-12 solutions. The Rosetta Course solution was used for all proficiency levels to supplement classroom instruction. It was also used to build language skills through independent study for languages not offered in the classroom. The Rosetta Stone TOTALe PRO solution was used primarily for intermediate-to-advanced students in select languages because of the powerful social learning environments that would help learners gain the confidence to speak the language outside the classroom. For classroom study, they used the Rosetta Stone® solution to "bridge the immersion gap" caused by block scheduling which kept students away from the language classroom for days at a time. Teachers would require students to study 2−3 lessons every other day and students were assigned a grade based on progress in the program. A teaching assistant was assigned to help monitor and manage learner study using the administrative tool, Rosetta Stone Manager™.

### **Building confidence to speak**

The Rosetta Stone solution was implemented at AITE to increase confidence to speak in the language studied. AITE found this especially challenging with intermediate and advanced learners. Targeting these learners with the Rosetta Stone TOTALe® PRO K-12 solution, the school realized significant increases in the willingness of students to converse with others inside and outside of the language classroom. The Rosetta Studio® sessions were especially helpful in launching students into wanting to communicate with others. One learner stated, "I found the TOTALe Rosetta Stone Studio session to be very helpful in improving my Spanish vocabulary in addition to improving my ability to have a conversation with someone in Spanish." At first they seemed petrified about the idea of speaking to a complete stranger, but after the first five minutes they were laughing and communicating." For learners in both Rosetta Course and TOTALe, the proprietary speech recognition technology allowed them to isolate sounds and move toward better pronunciation. Overall, the Rosetta Stone® solution met the goal of the school to have students converse in their new language.

#### Bridging the immersion gap

AITE implemented the Rosetta Stone solution in the language classroom to help overcome the challenges experienced with block scheduling. Using this scheduling process meant that learners would many times go days before they would be in the classroom with their language teacher. The Rosetta Stone solution was used to bridge this time away from the classroom so that learners could continue to build language skills and confidence to speak. Learner progress was defined based on 2−3 lessons of the program every other day. The administrative tool, Rosetta Stone Manager™, was used to monitor and manage study. Learners were assigned a grade based on progress made in the program. By building the Rosetta Stone solution into language courses, AITE found that students were more confident and engaged when the schedule allowed them to return to the language classroom.

## Implementing for success

AITE focused on implementing the Rosetta Stone solution to gain the most out of the solution given the diverse needs of the school. The school had access to both Rosetta Course and Rosetta Stone TOTALe PRO K-12 solutions. They assigned the appropriate Rosetta Stone solution where it would add the most value for the school. The Rosetta Stone TOTALe PRO solution was used for intermediate and advanced students to supplement classroom instruction. These learners were actively conversing in the classroom and needed the program to continue building skills when away from the teacher. The Rosetta Stone Course solution was targeted for beginners to help get learners gain the confidence to speak their new language. It was also used to build language skills through independent study for languages not offered in the classroom.

Another key to success was the selection of a teaching assistant to co-administrate the program with the coordinator. The assistant would actively monitor and manage student study through the administrative tool, Rosetta Stone Manager. "Using the reporting tools as well as my own data management skills, I was able to see the difference that Rosetta Stone made with all the students in a quantifiable manner", states Aaron Levy, teaching assistant for AITE's World Language Department. Reports were generated 3-4 times per quarter on learner progress and shared with faculty at the school. The assistant also ensured that the transition from one academic year to another was smooth and effective.
