

Set Up Your Profile



- 1. Once you click on the link, your name and username (which is your e-mail address) will appear on the screen. Next you will need to define your profile before launching Rosetta Stone®.
 - Set up your password. A minimum of 6 characters is needed for the password and special characters are accepted.
 - Specify your native language from the drop down menu.
 - Define your voice type. You can select either male or female.
 - Now you will need to select your time zone so that you can receive support in your local time zone.
 - Agree to the Terms of Use and Interactive Privacy Policy by clicking on Agree and Continue.



3. When you have completely answered all self-assessment questions, you will be given a CEFR level based on your results. Click "Start Learning".








Future Signing In
