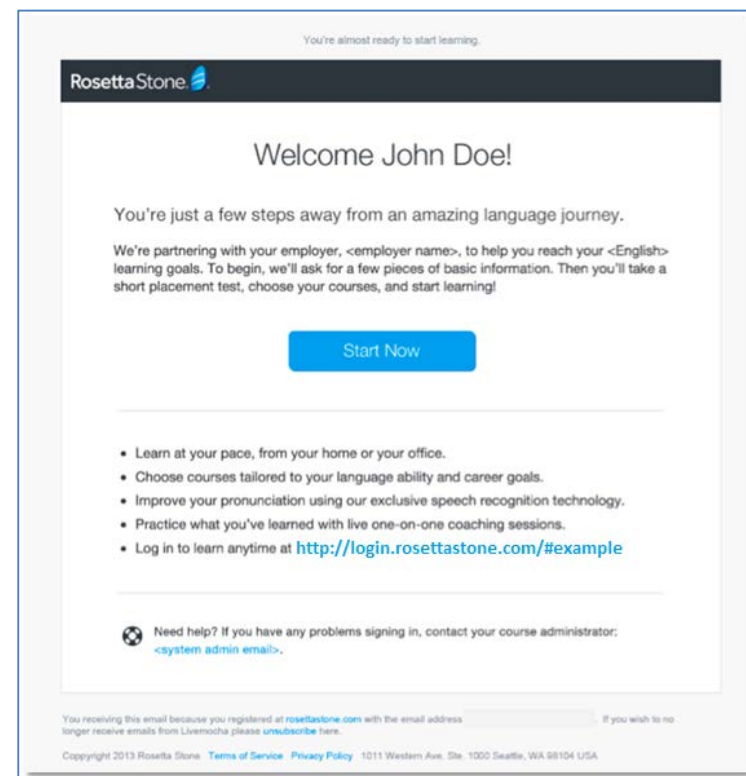


Set Up Your Profile

1. Once you have agreed to participate, you will receive an e-mail including a unique URL link to sign in to the Rosetta Stone® Catalyst™ system to set up your personal profile.

Note: This link is different than the web address you will use moving forward. This is a link to your personal profile created upon registration and should not be shared with others.



1. Once you click on the link, your name and username (which is your e-mail address) will appear on the screen. Next you will need to define your profile before launching Rosetta Stone®.
 - Set up your password. A minimum of 6 characters is needed for the password and special characters are accepted.
 - Specify your native language from the drop down menu.
 - Define your voice type. You can select either male or female.
 - Now you will need to select your time zone so that you can receive support in your local time zone.
 - Agree to the Terms of Use and Interactive Privacy Policy by clicking on Agree and Continue.

3. When you have completely answered all self-assessment questions, you will be given a CEFR level based on your results. Click "Start Learning".




4. Your product will now be displayed on your Rosetta Stone landing page. Click on the arrow on the right to enter your product and begin learning!
