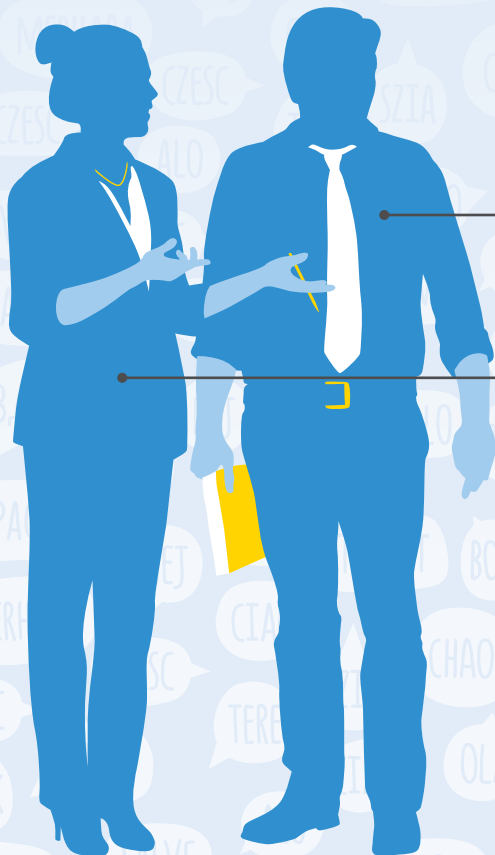


Qualities of a Great K-12 Administrator
